
Prayer for the Day

Data Protection by Design and Default - integrating robust privacy practices to ensure that personal data is protected from the outset and throughout its lifecycle.

The Christmas Card Question

It's December and many children will want to send Christmas cards to their classmates, and honestly, what could be nicer?! It is also reasonable to expect that parents may ask for a list of their children's class to make the process easier and ensure that everyone gets a card...



...And you can't give it to them. Giving out a class list is disclosing personal data. The task isn't essential to running a school, so you'd have to get consent. If you choose to go down that route that's fine, but you must ensure that explicit consent, for the purpose of Christmas cards, is in place for every child on any list you provide - a bit of a yuletide minefield.

So, the short and probably more realistic answer is that you can't hand out a list. I agree that this does sound a bit Grinch-like, but there are ways to keep the festive spirit alive and follow the law.

The GDPR doesn't apply to individuals only organisations so there is nothing to stop a pupil (or a parent for that matter for really young children) jotting down the names of everyone in the class.

On the home page you will be asked to enter your name and email address, create a password and choose who you work for from a dropdown menu (you should choose St Benet's) and this will then take you through to the welcome page. The Spectrum.Life service also includes access to 6 free counselling sessions (virtual or face-to-face) via the Employee Assistance Programme, access to a Discount Marketplace, advice on fitness, nutrition and many articles, videos and audios around wellbeing.
